



ORDINANCE NO. 2710

**AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING CHAPTER TEN
“BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATION” OF THE RANTOUL CODE
IN CONNECTION WITH
ADOPTION OF THE 2018 INTERNATIONAL SOLAR ENERGY PROVISIONS**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-3-2, provides that a municipality may adopt, by reference, certain regulations without setting forth those provisions in full; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 10 of the Village Code provides for the adoption by reference of certain codes published by the International Code Council; and,

WHEREAS, the International Code Council is made up of code enforcement officials, trade industry representatives, design professionals and other interested parties who participate in establishing and revising codes for adoption and use by municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, the International Code Council has published the 2018 edition of the International Solar Energy Provisions; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to adopt, by reference, the 2018 edition of the International Solar Energy Provisions as its Solar Energy Provisions code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. That CHAPTER 10 of the Village Code, entitled “Buildings and Building Regulation”, be and the same is hereby amended to add new Article XVII, entitled “Solar Energy Provisions”, as follows:

Article XVII International Solar Energy Provisions

Sec. 10-610. Adoption by reference.

A certain document, at least one copy of which is and has remained on file for a period of not less than 30 days prior to the adoption of the ordinance from which this article is derived and shall be kept available for public use in the office of the village clerk, being marked and designated as the International Solar Energy Provisions, 2018 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Solar Energy Provisions (the "solar energy provisions") of the Village, for regulating and governing solar energy systems as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees thereof; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the solar energy provisions are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this article.


Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall, after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, become effective on June 1, 2022.

Section 3. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 4. Publication. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.


