ORDINANCE NO. 2723

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 24 "PERSONNEL" OF THE RANTOUL CODE
IN CONNECTION WITH HOLIDAYS

WHEREAS, Rantoul Code Chapter 24 contains provisions pertaining to employees, including wages and benefits; and,

WHEREAS, Section 24-175 contains the holidays observed by the Village for its employees; and

WHEREAS, a new holiday has been instituted by the Federal government to be recognized, being the Juneteenth National Independence Day holiday; and,

WHEREAS, Section 24-175 should be updated to include the Juneteenth National Independence Day holiday.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. That Chapter 24, entitled "Personnel", Section 24-175, entitled "Paid holidays and holiday pay" be amended to provide as set forth as follows (with underlining being additions and strikethroughs being deletions):

Sec. 24-175. - Paid holidays and holiday pay.

(a) *Paid holidays and holiday pay.* Any full-time employee (and any part-time employee on a prorated basis) shall receive paid holidays, or holiday pay, whichever is applicable, for each of the holidays as follows:

New Year's Day

~~Martin Luther King's Birthday~~ Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr.

Good Friday

Memorial Day

Juneteenth National Independence Day

~~Fourth of July~~ Independence Day

Labor Day

Veteran's Day

Thanksgiving Day

Friday after Thanksgiving Day

Christmas Eve (~~only when falling on any weekday other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday~~)

Christmas Day

For any employee who is not assigned to a position having duties on a regularly scheduled shift, when the actual day of any of the preceding holidays falls on Saturday, the most previous Friday shall be considered as the paid holiday, and when the actual day of any of the preceding holidays falls on a Sunday, the next following Monday shall be considered as the paid holiday; provided, however, when the actual day of Christmas Eve falls on a Friday, the most previous Thursday

shall be considered as the paid holiday, and when the actual day Christmas falls on a Monday, the next following Tuesday shall be considered as the paid holiday.


Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 4. Publication. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.




